Forum of the 19 largest economies in the world and 2 economic blocs (EU, AU)

G20 accounts for 80% of world GDP, 75% of global trade and 60% of the population of the planet.

First time that Africa hosts the G20 presidency, following 3 prior Global South presidencies (Indonesia, India and Brazil)

The South African presidency themes are Solidarity, Equality and Sustainability

Official engagement group of the G20, dedicated to Gender Equality and Women's Economic Empowerment.


W20 develops recommendations to ensure that gender is mainstreamed and included in the G20 leaders' discussions and ultimately the Leaders' Declaration.


